- 4. Chili must be prepared **OFF** site, delivered and serve hot. Teams must provide a crock pot or other device to maintain the temperature of the chili.
- 5. Chili must be ready to serve at 5:00pm.
- 6. Chili will be served to the public in 2 oz. cups. (cups & spoons will be provided).
- 7. Public voting will end at 6:00pm and winners will be announced at 6:30pm.
- 8. Your entry form and indemnity Agreement must be received by September 27, 2021, See the <u>registration</u> page.
- 9. All entries **MUST** abide by the health and Food safety rules provided once you register.
- 10. The winner will be determined by PUBLIC VOTE counting for 70%, and a 3-judge panel counting for 30%.
- 11. Public vote will be determined by the entry receiving the most votes received during the event.
- 12. ONLY ONE WINNER WILL BE DECLARED.
- 13. In the event of a tie, all entries declared to be a tied by judges will receive equal prizes to be determined by officials of this event.
