Purpose of the Special Meeting is to get recommendations from the Webber Twp. Fire Chief for the new firetruck.

 - #3. (possible) to approve putting it on the tax roll.

The Board asks Chief Alan Dailey for his recommendation for a firetruck. His recommendation is to go with **Spence**r for the new truck for a total of **\$868,741.00**. Roll call vote: Kelly McCune absent, Dan Cousar yea, Pat Williams yea, Kathy Young yea, Ernie Wogatzke yea. 4 yea, 1 absent, motion carries. *note: Supervisor Wogatzke gave his vote to the public, for the few that spoke they felt we should follow the Chief's recommendation.
