Motion by Kathy Young supported by Pat Williams to open the Public Hearing. All present in favor, 4 yea, 1 absent, motion carries.

It is reported by resident signatures, that 51% of residents in the assessment district are in favor of the Jeanne Drive Special Road Assessment District. Supervisor Wogatzke read two letters from residents that are against the Special Assessment, noting that they don't feel that non-permanent residents should pay, because they don't utilize this service for part of the year.

Moving forward, with a 51% approval from residents of Jeanne Drive, the Webber Township Board sets a date of November 10, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. to hold the second Public Hearing for Jeanne Drive Special Road Assessment District.
